The desire to immerse ourselves more profoundly in the creative act of designing a facility sparked the genesis of our Immersive Design Process. This innovative approach starkly contrasts the outdated meet-disperse-re-meet model prevalent in the planning and schematic design phases.


Picture this: a series of two-to-three-day intensive workshops hosted at our client's places of business, replacing the traditional approach with a dynamic, collaborative experience. This departure from the norm builds critical team momentum and accelerates the design schedule, mitigating the project lag often associated with long durations between meetings.

HMC's Immersive Design Process is a continuous flow of information, design, feedback, and approvals, fostering consensus and delivering impactful projects in record time. Designing with key stakeholders in the room, those who will be instrumental in running the facility, significantly affect outcomes, reducing the need for revisions to space layouts.

While our primary interface during this process is with the executive leadership group, which is responsible for final decision-making, we actively involve multiple stakeholder groups. This inclusive approach ensures that diverse perspectives are considered, echoing a commitment to justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion. Simultaneously, we delve into the site's indigenous history and physical, natural, architectural, cultural, and social context, allowing these factors to shape and influence the design.

The duration of the Immersive Design Process, leading to schematic design deliverables, varies based on the size and complexity of the project. Smaller projects can be completed within a one or two-month cycle, while more extensive endeavors, such as a new high school, may take three months.

MORNING

HMC holds listening sessions and presents ideas with our clients, their user groups, and the community. Our client's leadership team then offers input and suggestions for next steps.

MID-DAY

HMC works on site to refine and continue developing ideas based on client feedback.

We created an immersive design process that engages our clients, and results in real-time decision making. We work side by side with you to test ideas in real time while building consensus along the way.

This process continues until we complete schematic design.



AFTERNOON

HMC meets with client and user groups to present ideas and receive feedback.

EVENING

HMC works that night to refine ideas to present to our client's leadership team and key staff members in the morning.

We had a week-long interactive design charrette with HMC at the project's inception, allowing my team and me to provide design input and get our ideas into the project from its outset. Each set of meetings within the process has a distinct focus and goal:

First meetings: Delve into understanding and documenting each group's project challenges and opportunities, prioritizing project goals.

Second meetings: Illustrate how we listen and translate comments into design ideas while continuing to seek input.

Third meetings: Tailor the design to the client's specific needs by refining details.

Fourth meetings: Finalize the schematic design, obtaining approval from all respective parties.
